Regarding John Holland Pty Ltd's Waterway Works Licence WC880 for the Murrumbidgee to Googong pipeline (M2G) project and the request of 14 October 2010 to vary this licence.

Licence Conditions

- 1 This licence is valid until 30 September 2012. The licence holder may apply to the Environment Protection Authority to extend this period.
- Waterway works permitted under this licence include 'removal of river sand for testing eductor (Environmental Work Method Statement BWA-M2G-EN-EWMS-14-0)'. The licence holder is to measure turbidity of water quality at the location of eductor testing, and upstream and downstream of the location of eductor testing, and report this information to the Environment Protection Authority within 14 days of eductor testing.
- 3 The work is to be undertaken in such a manner to minimise any erosion or sediment loss from the site and disturbed land is to be stabilised as soon as possible after work is completed.
- 4 It is the licence holder's responsibility to ensure that the structure is properly and safely constructed and maintained so that it does not pose a risk to persons or property.
- 5 Low flows must be able to pass through Angle Crossing.
- No other waterway works associated with Murrumbidgee to Googong Pipeline may occur under this licence, with exception of activities specified in Licence Condition 2. The licence holder must otherwise apply to ammend this licence and supply adequate details for consideration by the Environment Protection Authority.

At a minimum, the licence holder is to prepare the following plans for consideration by the Environment Protection Authority: (i) Construction and decommissioning of pumping station - Construction Environmental Management Plan; (ii) Construction and decommissioning of eductor pipe station - Construction Environmental Management Plan; (iii) Pipeline and waterway intersections - Construction Environmental Management Plan

Notes:

- 1. The issue of a Waterway Works Licence does not negate other relevant planning controls and guidelines that may apply to the property. Nor does it negate other Commonwealth or ACT legislative requirements such as those that may be necessary under the Environment Protection Act 1997.
- 2. The issue of a Waterway Works Licence on lands under a rural lease may require a Development Application for the works associated with the Waterway Works Licence.
