Did you know there are rules for using water?

Canberra and Queanbeyan's Permanent Water Conservation Measures are common sense rules for using water sensibly. They're similar to stage 1 temporary water restrictions in other parts of Australia.



Sprinklers / irrigation

Only to be used after 6pm or before 9am on any day.



Watering plants / lawn

A hand-held hose with a trigger nozzle, a bucket or a watering can be used at any time.



Paving, windows & buildings

A bucket and mop or high-pressure low-volume cleaner may be used to clean at any time.



Washing vehicles

If not washed at a commercial car wash, any vehicle should be washed on a lawn or other porous surface wherever practicable.
